## Travel Price Index | April 2023

The Travel Price Index (TPI) *decreased* by 0.8% in April (vs Mar.) while overall consumer prices (CPI) increased by 0.4%

- Airline Fares decreased by 2.6% while lodging prices decreased by 3.4%
- Motor Fuel prices *increased* by 2.8%

## On a year-over-year basis (YOY), inflation continued to cool down. CPI cooled to 4.9, while TPI cooled

to 2.8%%—in both cases, their lowest levels in two years

- Motor Fuel was *down* 12% YOY, while lodging was up 3.5%
- For the first time in many months, Airline Fares were *down* (by 0.9%) on a YOY basis
  - This is a major change from March when fares were up 18% YOY, and reflects the huge spike, both in travel and in fares, that occurred in April 2022 at which time many pandemic-related concerns were eased
  - In fact, this is the first time that fares were *down* YOY since November 2021 (and it follows 14 straight months when fares were up YOY by double digits)
