

## **Travel Price Index** | MAY 2022

The Travel Price Index (TPI) again grew faster than overall consumer prices (CPI) in May 2022

- CPI was up 1.0% compared to April 2022, while TPI was up 2.4% (seasonally adjusted)
- By far, the main catalyst for TPI growth in May was airfare, which after growing by a staggering 18.6% in April, grew by another 12.6% in May.

On a year-over-year basis, TPI growth (+19.4%) was much higher than CPI (+8.6%) but that reflects the particularly low travel prices last year. Even compared to 2019, however, TPI (+18.7%) inflation has now surpassed that of CPI (+14.1%) for the third straight month:

- Airfare was up 38% YOY. More noteworthy, however, is that May marked the second month since the pandemic that airfare surpassed 2019 levels and was up by 22% compared to May 2019.
- Motor fuel was up by a staggering 49% YOY and 54% compared to 2019
- Hotel/motel prices were up 22% YOY and 11% compared to 2019
