Travel Price Index | March 2023

The Travel Price Index (TPI) increased by 0.9% in March (vs Feb.) while overall consumer prices (CPI) increased by 0.1%

- Airline Fares increased by 4.0% while lodging prices increased by 3.1%
- Motor Fuel prices *decreased* by 4.7%

On a year-over-year basis (YOY), CPI cooled down to 5.0%, while TPI cooled to 4.9%

- Motor Fuel was *down* 17% YOY, while lodging was up 8%
- Airline Fares remained high on a YOY basis at +18%
 - When compared to March 2019, however, Airline Fares were up just 10%, considerably less than overall inflation during that four-year period (+19%)
