Travel Price Index (TPI) | September 2023

Travel prices, reflected by TPI, increased again in September both on a monthly and YOY basis.

- TPI increased by 1.8% in September vs August (seasonally adjusted), its highest monthly increase in nearly a year.
- On a year-over-year basis, travel prices were up 4.4% in September, a significant increase from +2.2% in August and being on par with 2022 levels in July.
- In comparison, overall prices (reflected by CPI) were up 0.4% on a monthly basis and 3.7% year-overyear.

Motor Fuel was up 2.2% in September vs August, and up 2.7% year-over-year.

• This marked a significant setback from the -20% YOY rates in July.

Airfare increased slightly (+0.3%) on a monthly basis but was still down 13% year-over-year.

Lodging prices were up 4.2% in September vs August, and +8.0% YOY.

Recreation and food/beverage-away-from-home prices were up 6.5% and 6.0% YOY, respectively.
