## **EDUCATING**

DMOs employ some of the best and the brightest teams from a diverse range of backgrounds, career paths and academic disciplines. The Destinations Council has created the Emerging Leaders Program to celebrate leaders starting out their careers in the DMO space. The program's two-year commitment provides participants with mentorship, experience sitting on an industry advisory council and the ability to affect change with fresh perspectives.

## **ADVOCATING**

The Destinations Council works to amplify U.S. Travel's efforts to reform travel policies. Members serve as champions for the legislative interests of their organizations and the industry as a whole. The council is represented at all U.S. Travel board meetings, develops valuable advocacy tools for members to strengthen their voice at the local and national levels and provides resources to members to navigate the process of building their business back in the era of COVID-19.

#### **ENGAGING**

The Destinations Council makes networking a top priority during their meetings, peer open forum sessions and as part of the annual Destiny Awards—a recognition of destination marketing excellence awarded at ESTO. The Destinations Council largely informs the trends and content presented at ESTO.

## **EMERGING LEADERS**

The council has launched a first-of-its-kind mentorship program—the Emerging Leaders program. This new effort provides destination marketing professionals unique opportunities to grow leadership skills and advance their careers in the travel industry.
