1:15-4:30 p.m. **OPTION 1: EXPLORE SEVEN FALLS**
Wear comfortable shoes—there is a lot of walking. The approach to Seven Falls, on National Geographic’s list of International Waterfalls, is called “The Grandest Mile of Scenery in Colorado.” Crystal clear water from the Pikes Peak watershed has shaped this natural box canyon and the towering Pillars of Hercules flanking it rise over 900 feet above the canyon floor. For those who want to explore more, take the 224 steps by the side of the falls that lead to hiking trails and the banks of the glistening stream that feeds the falls.

1:15-4:30 p.m. **OPTION 2: FOOTHILLS AND GARDEN OF THE GODS JEEP TOUR**
The guided tours leave The Broadmoor and head into the foothills of Pikes Peak and the Rocky Mountains. The views are beautiful and the flora and rock formations are constantly changing. The tour stops at Helen Hunt Falls, with incredible views 2,000 feet above Colorado Springs, and then joins the Shortline Railroad where you will pass through two historic railroad tunnels. You will complete the ride with a tour of Garden of the Gods, registered as a National Historic Landmark. Your photo opportunities are unobstructed in open-air Jeeps.

1:00-5:00 p.m. **OPTION 3: ZIPLINING**
No one under 6 years old; No one under 50 lbs. or over 250 lbs.; please wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. Zipline over the foothills of historic Manitou Springs over Gregory Gulch, and enjoy spectacular vistas while soaring over this beautiful alpine canyon. The natural-terrain course features five ziplines, varying in length from 225 feet to over 600 feet, and provides a great rush of adrenaline! You will be launching and landing on dirt trails, so closed toe shoes are required.

OPTION 4: U.S. TRAVEL GOLF OUTING
(Includes box lunch) A combination of the original 1918 Donald Ross design and the Robert Trent Jones, Sr. 1964 design, The Broadmoor’s West Course offers a challenging experience with spectacular views. Get ready for rolling fairways, multi-level greens, and demanding hazards at this stunning yet formidable course. Go directly to the clubhouse, where box lunches will be available for pick-up. We’ll have a shotgun start at 1:00 p.m. Beverages will also be provided.
