

WEEKLY CORONAVIRUS IMPACT ON TRAVEL EXPENDITURES IN THE U.S.

(APRIL 16, 2020 UPDATE)

NATIONAL FINDINGS

Travel spending in the U.S. continued its descent last week, although declines are leveling off as virtually all non-essential travel has been eliminated.

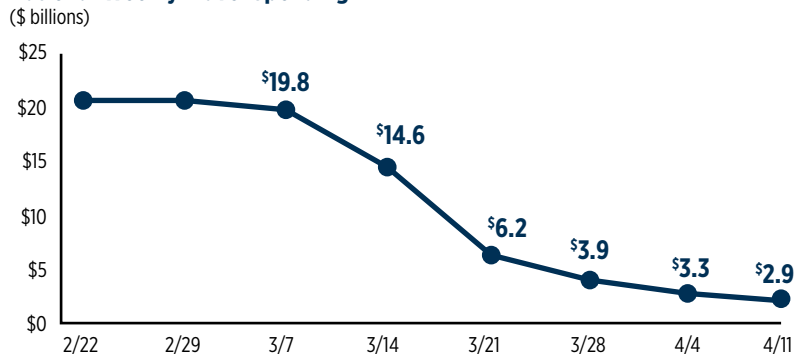
National weekly travel spending fell to \$2.9 billion last week. This is a mere 15% of the nearly \$20 billion spent during the first week of March.

In the week ending April 11th the travel economy fell 87% below last year's levels, marking a continued decline in the travel economy as lockdowns affect most of the country.

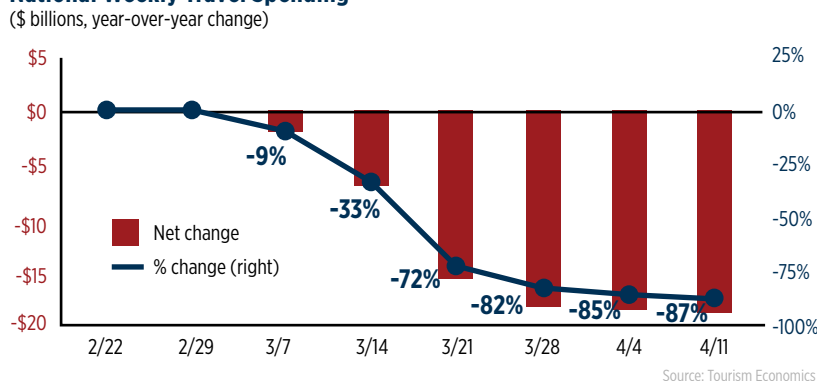
Travel spending appears to have stabilized at historically low levels, registering \$19 billion lower than the same week a year ago.

Since the beginning of March, the COVID-19 pandemic has resulted in \$80 billion in losses for the U.S. travel economy.

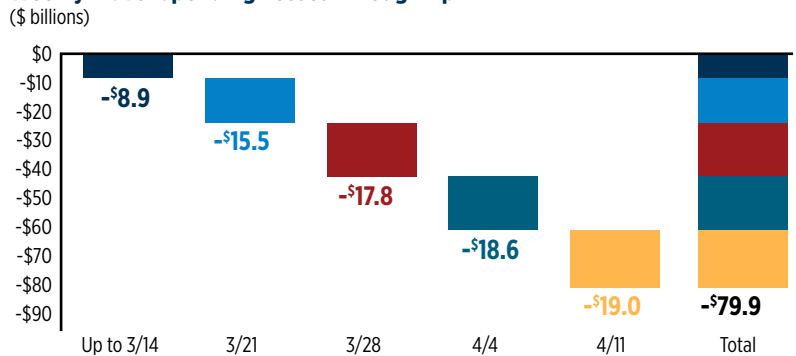
National Weekly Travel Spending

REGIONAL FINDINGS

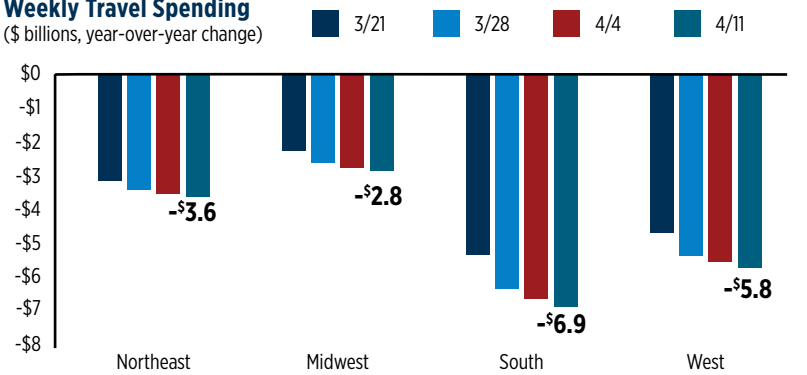
Travel spending losses for the week ending on April 11th reached \$3.6 billion in the Northeast, \$2.8 billion in the Midwest, \$6.9 billion in the South, and \$5.8 billion in the West Census region.

Over the past six weeks, cumulative losses have tallied \$15.7 billion for the Northeast, \$11.7 billion for the Midwest, \$28.0 billion for the South, and \$24.5 billion for the West.

The West has surpassed the Northeast to lead all regions in percentage losses for the week with an 87% decline. All regions are experiencing declines in the range of 84% to 87%.

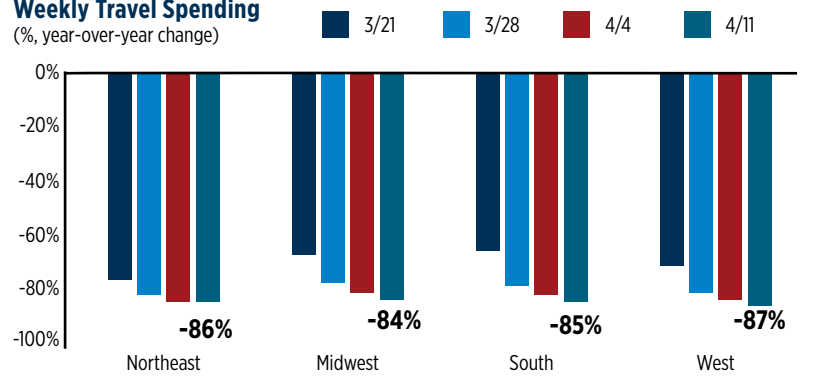
Weekly Travel Spending

(\$ billions, year-over-year change)



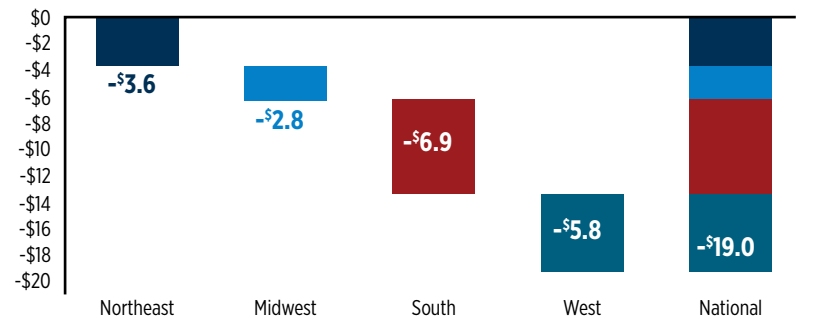
Weekly Travel Spending

REGIONAL FINDINGS (CONTINUED)

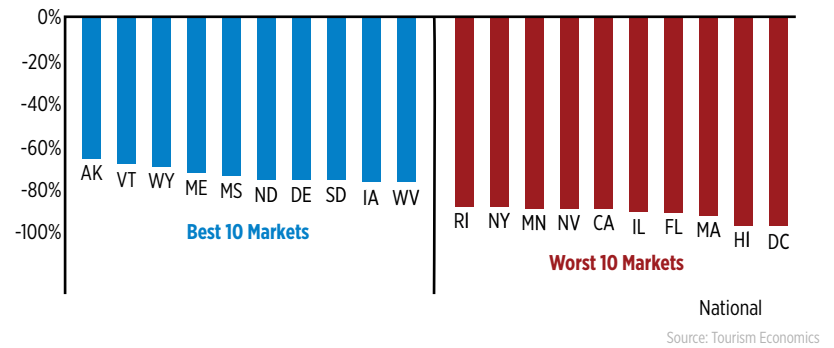
States that are less reliant on international travel and those without large urban centers have fared relatively better than their counterparts. Alaska, Vermont, and Wyoming are the only states to suffer a decline of less than 70% last week.

The District of Columbia, Hawaii, Florida, Massachusetts, Florida, and Illinois averaged declines of more than 90% in the week ending April 11th.

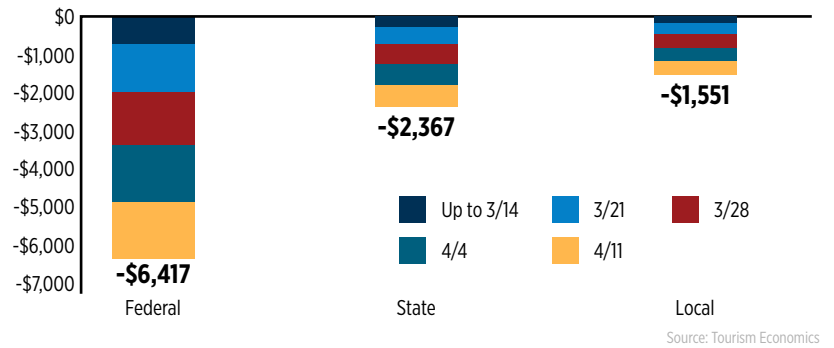
These substantial losses in travel spending have caused a loss of \$10.3 billion in federal, state, and local tax revenue since March 1st.

This includes \$6.4 billion in federal taxes, \$2.4 billion in state taxes, and \$1.5 billion in local tax revenue.
