

During the coronavirus (COVID-19) emergency, [Zoom](#) meetings and meet ups have increased in use to help stay connected even when practicing social distancing. Here's how to create a graphic that your residents, visitors and colleagues can upload to their zoom accounts to put themselves in your destination or business.

## Image requirements:

- GIF, JPG/JPEG or PNG – transparent areas of PNGs will be shown on a white background
- At least **960px** wide but no more than **1920px**
- Zoom suggests: 1920px by 1080px (**16:9**)
- No more than **5 MB**
- You can even add animations! Just make sure it is saved as an **mp4**

## Share your image with your audience:

Post your custom images or animations on your site with simple instructions for your audience to access and use:

1. Once in a meeting, click the camera icon and **Choose Virtual Background**
2. Click the **+ icon** (make sure to allow Zoom to access your images)
3. Select our image to put yourself in **DESTINATION/BUSINESS**

**Use your images to connect with your colleagues and team.** If you manage your team's paid account you can change the default background for all your Zoom Rooms in your account:

- Log on to your account (make sure you are the account owner or admin)
- Go to **Room Management** and select **Zoom Rooms**
- Click **Account Settings** at the top of the page
- In the **Account Profile** tab, under **Background Image for Zoom Rooms**, click **Upload New Image**
- Select your photo to share your destination's spirit
