Starting October 1, 2020
FORMS OF ACCEPTABLE ID
for domestic flights

- REAL ID-compliant driver's license
- Passport or Passport Card
- U.S. military ID
- DHS Trusted Traveler card (ex. Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)
- Enhanced Driver's License (MI, MN, NY, VT and WA)

1 CHECK FOR THE STAR
REAL ID-compliant licenses are generally marked with a star located in the upper portion of the card.

2 GET A REAL ID
Contact your department of motor vehicles or driver's license agency to learn your state's REAL ID process. Make sure you have all necessary documentation.

3 UNABLE TO GET A REAL ID?
If you're unable to get a REAL ID before **October 1, 2020**: TSA will accept other forms of ID so you can still board your flight, including:

- U.S. passport or passport card
- U.S. military ID
- DHS Trusted Traveler cards (Global Entry, NEXUS, SENTRI, FAST)

4 SPREAD THE WORD
Make sure your family and friends are **#REALIDready** before October 1, 2020.



Whether you travel once a year or once a month, all travelers will need a REAL ID in order to fly within the U.S. starting October 1, 2020. Don't wait: Get **#REALIDready** now.
